

OPERATING RULES OF THE CAMP SOUMARSKÝ MOST

in the sense of the guidelines for the operation of tourist accommodation facilities Sb. ref.
2047/92 published by SSAŠ ZO Automotoklub VOLARY

1. The visitor of the camp is obliged to register with the camp administrator upon presentation of the camp and present his / her identity card. The owner of the dog is obliged to present the vaccination card of the dog.
2. The visitor of the camp is obliged to get acquainted with the operating rules of the camp and the statute of the Šumava National Park and to observe its provisions for the entire period of stay.
3. The camp administrator shall allocate a place for camping, parking the vehicle or a trailer and assign a registration number to the tent and the vehicle.
4. In case of early termination of the stay, the amounts paid will not be refunded.
5. The use of the camp is permitted for persons who are not affected by infectious diseases or diseases causing resistance.
6. Night rest must be observed between 22:00 and 06:00. Discussions by the campfires can be held even after this time, but so as not to disturb the peace of others.
7. During the day, it is not allowed to bother the users of the camp with shouting, noisy expressions, excessive amplification of radios, smoke, odours, waste, behaviour of pets, etc.
8. Driving motor vehicles and bicycles is allowed only on access roads.
9. Free movement of dogs throughout the camp is prohibited.
10. Every visitor is obliged to observe safety measures, especially to take extra care when lighting a fire. It is strictly forbidden to start fires in peat bogs, forest areas, roads and access roads.
11. The camp visitor is responsible for properly extinguishing the fire on departure.
12. The camp visitor is obliged to immediately notify the camp administrator of any spread of fire.
13. Burning of stands and old grass is prohibited according to §17 of Act no. 133/1985 Sb.
14. Fire safety is governed by Act No. 133/1985 Sb.
15. Personal hygiene is prohibited for wells with drinking water.
16. Every visitor is obliged to maintain order and cleanliness in the camp.
17. The person who damaged the camp equipment is obliged to compensate the administrator in full.
18. Before leaving the camp, the visitor will restore the place of his tent and its surroundings to its original condition.
19. Visitors to the camp are obliged to obey the instructions of the camp administrator without reservations.
20. The operating organization shall not be liable for injuries, damage or theft of the property of the camp users. Nor is it liable for the loss of things and property.
21. In the event of a gross violation of the camp's operating rules or intolerant behaviour (e.g. under the influence of alcohol), the administrator has the right to exclude an individual or a group of persons from the accommodation, without the right to a refund.
